

DeSoto County Stormwater Information

Much of DeSoto County is rural, so agricultural runoff is a greater concern than urban runoff. Stormwater in unincorporated areas is handled by the [Road and Bridge Department](#). Responsibilities include the construction and maintenance of over 420 miles of roadway and approximately 750 miles of drainage ditches in the unincorporated areas of DeSoto County. Other functions include the operation and maintenance of storm water and flood control structures in various locations throughout the County. The department also houses the vehicle and equipment maintenance providing service and repairs for County vehicles and equipment.
